WELCOME TO THE INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF NANTES

The ISN (International School of Nantes), Ecole Internationale Bilingue de Nantes, welcomes children of all nationalities, from ages 3 months to 11 years old, from nursery to the end of primary school.

With a forest covering 2 hectares in the backdrop, the school offers **a work and life setting which is calm and fulfilling**, allowing children to reconnect with nature on a daily basis whilst developing respect of their individuality, their needs and capacities.

Our Bilingual Nursery offers the little ones (0-2 ages) an environment that is calm, pleasant and safe, favouring the well-being and early development of our “Babies”.

The Bilingual Kindergarten welcomes children from ages 2 to 6.

The Bilingual Kindergarten and Primary School both follow the French and English academic programs which are enriched and completed by international programs with recognized methods and also by the introduction of “life” disciplines, taught on a daily basis, such philosophy.

In our school children benefit from teaching and activities which are **totally bilingual: 50% French – 50% English.**

Our teaching team is multicultural, native and highly qualified.

The intake of our classes is limited in order to allow supported and work on a one-to-one level as well as numerous stimulating activities. We offer students teaching and educational methods which are regularly updated with respect to the latest advances in neurosciences and different studies on learning.

Our school is located a few minutes away from the city centre of Nantes. **A school shuttle service will be organized from September in the city centre and around the city. The school bus route and meeting points will be determined according to the needs of each family.**

Enrollment for the new school year 2017-2018 has started. For Further information, you are welcome to the school. We will be there every Wednesday between 2 and 6pm.

AN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL

At the ISN, children of all nationalities learn and grow together. They come together and create wonderful friendships.

Our professional team and our pupils are multicultural, thus the school is immersed in **a truly international atmosphere. The commonly spoken language for the small and older children is English.**

This cultural diversity makes exchanges and cooperation all the more interesting, and it also helps children **to be more open to new experiences, now and in the future.**

We follow both the French and English academic programs to which we have added subjects that we also consider essential, such as philosophy or meditation. Our pupils also work on international extracurricular projects which are defined at the beginning of the year by the teaching staff and the families.

Our aim is not only to have our pupils understand the topics covered, but also to apply the working methods, research, and analysis. We also encourage them to develop a critical mind, to think in **a critical way and develop an overall perspective that allows them to demonstrate empathy, compassion, and respect for others and their environment.**

Moreover, every year the pupils obtain their Cambridge certificates which are recognized all over the world and can lead to international studies and careers. This greatly enhances their chances of creating the future and life of their choice.

The parents are also invited to take part in this multicultural project through the PTA (Parents Teachers Association) by participating in various events throughout the year and inviting the children to discover their respective cultures and traditions.

This is how our pupils learn to become responsible, respectful, caring and open-minded global citizens.

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OUR MISSION AND OUR PHILOSOPHY

Our role, even more so as an international school, is to prepare the children to become tomorrow's citizens: citizens of the "world" who will be fulfilled, open and responsible. Citizens who will know how to stand up in front of the major challenges of their time in a positive way and with confidence.

Encouraging children to be open to the world by learning two languages from a very young age

Learning a language means opening up to others' cultures, becoming aware of diversity and respecting and honouring it. At the ISN, it is from this perspective that we lay the foundations of bilingualism. We look at language diversity as an asset and a huge contribution for all children. In our school, being international is not just a theory but a value that we live through every day. Our pupils progress in a bilingual environment and in an international setting which is guaranteed by the multicultural experience of our team and pupils.

Educating a critical mind

We encourage our children to develop their capacities to think in a critical and creative way in order to analyse, take responsible decisions and initiatives to handle complex issues.

Learning is also about being able to self-reflect and communicate with others in a positive and constructive way. Besides the acquisition of fundamental knowledge, the development of a critical mind is very important to us. We encourage our pupils to question themselves, to ask themselves "why" and not only "how". We've introduced philosophy in our curriculum to help children understand the world better, give them more confidence in their capacities to learn and solve problems – precious skills that will be of use throughout their whole life.

Putting an emphasis on a sense of cooperation

We cultivate cooperation between the pupils rather than competition. We see cooperation as an essential step in learning. Individualization is not sufficient, everything has to be done so that a dynamic exchange is possible. It is in this dual movement that we learn: helping others move forward while doing so oneself. It is just as important to facilitate the mechanism of understanding as it is to acquire knowledge. "I help you to understand, you help me to learn."

We are convinced that the future belongs to those who will know how to cooperate and help each other. Our pupils regularly work on school projects or extra-curricular activities which help them become aware that if a group functions properly, it can set objectives that no individual can hope to reach on his own.

Encouraging experimentation and creativity

Experimentation holds a very important place in our teaching. We develop our pupils' curiosity and needs of discovery by encouraging them to try and explore freely. On top of bringing meaning to teaching and conciliating theory and practice, it allows us to nourish their innovating, creative minds and their self-confidence.

Developing a culture of "everything is possible" and of "the right to make a mistake"

We wish our children to grow in a very secure environment in which they feel free and respected. We encourage them to act, to imagine, to explore and to assert themselves. At ISN, a mistake is not a weakness to ban but an experiment that allows to move forward.

Working towards a caring school

We attach value to children's success and progress. We encourage and comfort each child according to their personality and needs, for we are convinced that only a caring and encouraging attitude can give a child the desire to persevere.

The importance of soft skills and emotional intelligence

Above all we regard school as a place where our children learn how to live together. Asserting oneself whilst respecting others, knowing how to express and control their emotions whilst staying aware of others' emotions, acting with compassion and altruism are essential life qualities that we have to learn children to develop.

Becoming a world citizen

The world issues call for an urgent introduction of new content in education and mainly the emergence of a new, more responsible and respectful attitude. We encourage children to be sensitive to environmental and social issues in order to make them responsible citizens and prompt them to actively participate in the construction and transformation of our society rather than submit to its effects. Our pupils follow classes each week on citizenship and philosophy. They work all-year-round on international, environmental and social projects which are chosen at the beginning of the year by parents and the teaching team. We also encourage children, parents, and the whole of our team to support and participate in a certain number of projects and initiatives either on a local, national or international level.

Building our pupils' autonomy and appetite for learning

The school has an important part to play in building the children's autonomy. Our teaching methods empower the children to learn and give them freedom to search, select and exploit pieces of information, or proceed to experiment to build up their knowledge. "Trial and error" experimentation, problem solving situations and cognitive conflict constitute the core of the learning process by giving them confidence in their own success and developing their eagerness to learn by guiding them towards the sense of personal satisfaction.

The importance of reconnecting mind and body

We consider that the well-being of the mind is automatically connected to the body. Thanks to concentration and yoga workshops, we train children to be in the present moment, to be able to know and listen to their body, to welcome and control their emotions in order to feel more fulfilled and pay more attention, particularly in their learning.

The importance of nature

We consider that nature holds an important part in teaching. It allows a one-hand experimentation and discovery through real situations and on the other hand it raises awareness on how important it is to respect and sustain nature. Situated next to a two-hectare forest, the school benefits from having exceptional natural surroundings which allow the practise of many outdoor and sportive activities for all ages: mountain biking, sports ground in a clearing, fitness path, but also opportunities to observe nature's cycle of life for the youngest ones.

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A BALANCED BILINGUAL LEARNING

To learn a language, one has to live with it and share it with others, young and old. At the ISN, children learn **how to express themselves with confidence and creativity, in both languages.**

Our pupils learn French and English in a natural way, thanks to our immersion method and **a native English and French teaching team who are qualified and experienced.**

The teaching is bilingual and equally balanced: 50% of school time in French and 50% in English. This starts right from the youngest class in the nursery school (i.e. 2 years old). The French academic curriculum is followed and reinforced. In English, the children follow the English official national curriculum.

The intake of our classes is limited in order to allow supported and work on a one-to-one level as well as numerous stimulating activities.

WELCOMING ALL CHILDREN OF ALL NATIONALITIES... AND OF ALL LANGUAGES

Teaching French as a foreign language

Teaching English as a foreign language ("English as a second language").

As an international school, we welcome all children: French speaking, English speaking, but also all nationalities and those who speak neither French nor English. The "teaching French and English as a foreign language" department plays an important part in welcoming and supporting children who come from various cultural linguistic backgrounds. Through a one-to-one teaching approach, intensive adapted language courses support the integration of pupils, while respecting each individuals' needs and allowing all children to be able to follow classes in both languages.

THE ISN, CENTER FOR THE CAMBRIDGE CERTIFICATE

Diplomas from the University of Cambridge are among the most recognized English certificates in the world. The Cambridge exams are organized each year within the school by the Cambridge examiners offering children a concrete objective and allowing them to validate their level in comparison to the international levels.

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A MULTICULTURAL, QUALIFIED AND MOTIVATED TEAM

At the ISN, your children are welcomed and looked after by qualified and experienced professionals from different nationalities who share the values and philosophy of the school.

School is life, movement, and change. Teaching methods progress with neuroscience advancements and with the different studies on teaching. We put a particular emphasis on our teaching teams ongoing training.

OUR SCHOOL

We offer:

A mini Bilingual Nursery with vacancies up to ten babies from three months old

A bilingual Kindergarten for all children aged from 2 to 6 years old (“très petite, petite, moyenne et grande sections”)

A bilingual Primary School for all classes from 6 to 11 (CP to CM2 or from year 1 to year 6)

A bilingual “Happy Club” welcoming children on Wednesday and part of the holiday period

THE BILINGUAL KINDERGARTEN

Our bilingual Kindergarten welcomes children from the age of 2 (from the day of their birthday), offering a welcoming, calm, fulfilling environment that is adapted to their needs. We help children develop their autonomy, self-confidence and above all, the eagerness to learn.

A ‘natural’ learning

From 2 years old, the children benefit from teaching and activities which are totally bilingual. Children participate in workshops in French in the morning and in English in the afternoon (or the other way round). **Daily contact with native teaching professionals promotes the learning of both languages to be done in a natural and fun way.**

We have small classes welcoming up to 15 children to encourage work on a one-to-one basis and many activities.

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The curriculum is taught in both languages and this in all skills.

Learning and Fulfillment

Our classes are equipped with educational materials from different active pedagogies, thereby promoting the awareness and fulfilment of each child, as well as his intellectual, sensory and emotional development.

Our gross motor activity room offers children different spaces adapted to their age and development. It allows the organization of multiple activities, games, relaxation and yoga.

Furthermore, the children are connected with nature on a daily basis. The school has **a garden and a large forest**. According to their age (and weather permitting) children can play, go for walks, build huts, explore nature, practice gardening.... The list is long! A clearing allows sports activities and collective games.

THE BILINGUAL PRIMARY SCHOOL

In primary education, beyond the acquisition of fundamental knowledge, pupils learn to collaborate with others and become responsible. We use kindness to encourage children to become self-sufficient, confident and, most of all, to enjoy learning.

Knowledge and soft skills

We follow both the French and English academic programs and offer all of the academic subjects.

We have decided to integrate Mind and Body Health sessions to our program, including philosophy workshops and the daily practice of concentration and yoga techniques that allow children to develop other essential skills for life.

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Our teaching team has specific trainings and is very much involved in our mission. Our teachers ensure that children are given social and moral values, teaching them to take care of themselves, others and their environment.

A bilingual teaching

The teaching is bilingual and fully balanced between both languages, that is to say 50% of the time taught in French and 50% of the time in English. Children have classes in French in the morning and in English in the afternoon (or the other way round). The intake of our classes is limited in order to allow supported and individualized work as well as numerous stimulating activities.

In the primary school, in order to respect both French and English curriculums, teaching is shared between the two languages as follows:

Concentration techniques

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A place of life

The school benefits from having exceptional natural surroundings: a forest and a clearing enabling children to reconnect with nature on a daily basis and practice many activities.

We have designed the school so that it is a genuine setting for daily living. That's to say, a place of learning that allows us to experiment in our FabLab, a workshop to make and create. A place that promotes cultural and artistic stimulation with a room dedicated to music and art; a yoga, dance and theatre and motor activity space which promotes motor skills, games and relaxation.

SCHOOL ORAGNIZATION

At the ISN, we follow the academic calendar implemented by the national education system for the Nantes zone.

The school year runs from September to the end of June.

School opening times

We welcome children from Monday to Friday, from 7.30am to 6.30pm. Classes are on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.

On Wednesday and during some of the school holidays the children can join the Happy Club, a bilingual vacation club.

Timetable

Kindergarten:

Classes are on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday

from 9am to 11.20am and from 2pm to 4.30pm.

Nap time is organised according to the needs of each child.

Primary school:

Classes are on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday

from 8.30am to 12.30pm and from 2pm to 4.50pm.

School Restaurant

There are two or three services for meals at lunchtime (kindergarten-primary).

The school also provides morning and afternoon snacks.

The menus are displayed every week and can be viewed on our website in the «ACTUS» section.

Our cooker offers well-balanced and varied meals. We strive to serve products from organic farming and fresh local products.

Special diets are respected; parents must provide a medical prescription. Children should not bring sweets to school.

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Tutoring

Tutoring takes place every evening, except on Wednesdays and the day prior to school holidays.

For the CP-CE1: from 5.10pm to 5.40pm /

For the CE2-CM1-CM2: from 5.10pm to 6pm.

School care

Kindergarten: every day from 7.30am to 9am and from 4.30pm to 6.30pm.

Primary School: every day from 7.30am to 8.30am and every evening after tutoring from 5.40pm for the CP-CE1 and after 6pm for CE2-CM1-CM2.

Happy Club

The Happy Club organizes activities and outings on Wednesdays and during school holidays. Proposed activities are: computer workshops, arts and crafts, games and sports, music, singing... The activity schedules will be displayed at the school reception area and can also be viewed on our website.

Sports activities

At the ISN, sport is practiced on a daily basis in various forms.

Kindergarten: Our teachers organize daily skill motor activities outside or in our gross motor activity room.

Primary School: Our activity room allows the practice of yoga, dance, and judo. In our clearing, the children will be able to practice various collective games and sports. We also plan to create a fitness track in the forest.

Motor activity room

The school has a motor skills room designed for children to move around and explore with complete freedom and safety. The room has different spaces that are adapted to the ages and needs of the children. It allows different activities to be organized such as gym, yoga, relaxation, etc.

Introduction to music course

In the Kindergarten, we propose musical workshops every week.

From the age of 4, children have a weekly musical course. The course is divided into two parts: music theory, rhythm, instruments, music history, and vocal techniques are followed by an individual course with the instrument of their choice (singing, piano, guitar).

Computing

The primary school classes are equipped with interactive whiteboards.

Pupils work together toward obtaining a certificate in computing supported by their teacher.

Mind & Body Health

The aim of the «Mind and Body Health» program is to provide the children with the necessary knowledge for a better quality of life on a daily basis and throughout their lives. This course includes philosophy workshops, sciences and neurosciences, physical activities such as yoga, and different techniques for relaxation and concentration.

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ISN FabLab

The aim of the FabLab, a workshop to make and create, is to involve children in concrete projects and challenges, thus motivating them to learn more. The FabLab allows children to experiment and put their ideas to the test, to create, to imagine and build.

Green activities

At the ISN, we help children become aware of the importance of protecting our environment. Throughout the year, they participate in different projects and activities such as learning to be environmentally-friendly, organic farm visits, gardening in our vegetable plot, learning to make compost and turning objects into works of art.

Extracurricular activities

At the beginning of the year, we propose a wide range of extracurricular activities (dance, judo, violin, Chinese, chess, theatre, etc.). The courses are held at the school on Wednesday and after classes. They are taught by external professionals with whom we work throughout the year. We are also open to exchanging with families who may have ideas for activities or even hidden talents.

School Trips

Each year we organise a school trip for primary school pupils. It enables children to discover new environments: mountains, wilderness classes and new activities such as sailing or water skiing. It's a good opportunity for children to explore and see other settings and allows them to take home wonderful memories of their trip.

School bus

For the new school year school, transport will be set up for children from the age of 4. The meeting points will be determined according to the needs and requests of each family.

Uniforms

From Kindergarten, children will wear a school uniform, which develops a sense of belonging to the school and the school community. The school will take care of ordering the aprons for the young children and the uniforms.

A parent-teacher meeting is organised at the start of each school year.

The Head of School remains at your disposal

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HOW TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD

We are aware that arriving at a new school is an important moment for every child and his or her parents. We make every effort to achieve a successful integration adapted to each child.

Admission Procedure

Please contact the Head of the School, Madame PAULIN, to make an appointment by phone: 09 73 28 29 22 or e-mail at contact@isnantes.fr. The enclosed registration form must then be delivered to the Director duly completed and accompanied by the documents requested.

Registrations during the year are possible depending on the places available. Registrations for the following school year are eligible from November of the previous year.

Kindergarten (2-6 ages)

Children can join the very small section from the age of two, on the date of their birthday and depending on the places available. Since we welcome only 15 children per class, it is strongly advised to anticipate the registration of one year. A period of adaptation, may be recommended.

Primary School (6-11 ages)

Following an assessment at the beginning of the year, support and refresher courses can be proposed to families.

Intensive language courses (FLE and EAL) are organized on Wednesdays to allow children to attend classes in both languages.

Documents to be provided for any application

- the duly completed registration form, dated and signed by both parents
- 2 identity photos
- the family booklet
- the health record booklet (vaccinations)
- the school record (Primary classes)
- the IBAN
- the personal insurance
- the medical certificate for sports hability (primary)
- full payment of registration fees

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GENERAL AND FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

1. Admission requirements

Registration of a new student is confirmed by receipt of the registration form and payment:

- registration fee
- participation in school equipment
- participation in the school development fund (Investments in digital equipment, international exchanges, development of ambitious and innovative educational programs, etc.)

Cancellation of registration

If you wish to cancel the registration of a student after admission, the school must be notified of the cancellation by letter with acknowledgment of receipt addressed to: IS NANTES 15, Rue Olympe de Gouges - 44800 Saint Herblain, as soon as possible.

The financial consequences are as follows:

- Registration fees will not be refunded.
- Reimbursement of the costs of participation in school material and the development fund is possible if the school is informed of the cancellation by letter with acknowledgment of receipt up to 15 days after the student's registration.
- If the cancellation of registration takes place after 15 days from the date of admission of the pupil, the amounts paid will not be reimbursed.

2- Re-registration

2.1- Conditions for re-registration

The school must receive the following documents and fees before the date indicated on the re-registration document:

- The re-enrollment application form duly completed and signed by both parents of the student.
- The payment of the costs of re-registration and participation in school materials

2.2- Conditions for cancellation of the re-registration

The cancellation of a re-registration must be notified to the school by letter with acknowledgment of receipt addressed to: IS NANTES 15, Rue Olympe de Gouges - 44800 Saint Herblain. The financial consequences of this cancellation will be different, depending on the date of cancellation:

- 1- Before March 15: the re-registration and participation fees will be reimbursed.
- 2- After March 15: the amounts paid will not be refunded.
- 3- After July 1st: the amounts paid will not be refunded and the first three monthly payments will be fully due.

2.3- Specific cases of cancellation of the re-registration

Reimbursement of reinstatement fees will be possible after March 15 in case of force majeure preventing the schooling of the child or the transfer of the parents leading to a relocation to another department.

3- School fees

3.1 The student is enrolled at the IS Nantes for the entire school year. The school fees (see tariffs) are annual. They are invoiced annually or in ten monthly installments depending on the choice of the families. For any annual payment in September 5% discount will be applied. In this case, school fees must be paid before 1 September. Monthly payments are sent to families each month and must be paid by the 3rd of the same month.

3.2. In the event of non-payment of school fees on the scheduled dates, late payment shall be subject to late payment interest fixed at the statutory rate plus two percentage points. Any collection costs whatsoever will be borne by the parents. In addition, the Management reserves the right not to accept the student in class.

4- Enrollment during the year

For students registering during the year at IS Nantes, the annual school fees are invoiced on a pro rata basis. The month in which the student arrives is invoiced in full.

5- Departure during the year

A departure that takes place during the year must be notified to the school management by letter with acknowledgment of receipt addressed to: IS NANTES 15, Rue Olympe de Gouges - 44800 Saint Herblain, as soon as possible, before the date of departure.

Tuition fees for the period in question will be due.

6- Civil liability

Families are financially responsible for the degradation of school premises and facilities by their children.

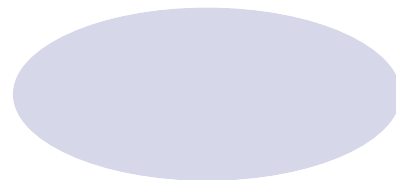

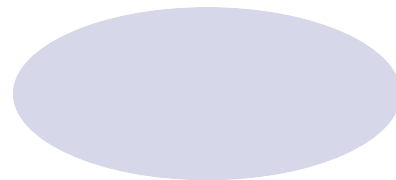
